### Personal Statement

My name is Isaac, a sophomore in the National University of Singapore pursuing a major in Data Science & Analytics. I am a highly motivated and dedicated individual. I have never shied away from difficult or intense situations. As someone who loves to be involved with the community, I often take up positions and participate in various activities. Through these uncomfortable and new situations, I develop myself as a person.

My interest in Data Science began even before my undergraduate studies. After my National Service ended, I started working on one of my major requirements, CS1010X Programming Methodology. This course pushed me to my limits, with no prior understanding or experience in coding, it was a very steep learning curve. However, with dedication, hard work, and many hours staring at errors, I eventually grew to adore programming. I jumped at the opportunity to use my newfound coding skills at my internship with Fuchs Capital Partners. This further cemented my passion for programming as I could see how the applications, I built for my colleagues greatly impacted their workflow and tangibly made their work easier. Till today I enjoy courses with computing components and even dive into hackathons and personal computing projects too.

Apart from hard skills, I am a meticulous person and a leader as well. I thrive in team-oriented environments and tend to be able to see the big picture when taking the lead on projects. Throughout my life, I have held various leadership and directorial positions. Since May 2023, I have been serving Sheares Hall as the Director of Media for the 43<sup>rd</sup> Junior College Room Committee. I spent every spare moment combing through Investopedia, asking questions on how things worked and why they worked. Originally, I was meant to just handle daily report generation and Profit & Loss calculations. However, I quickly mastered these tasks and began to do more. As we utilized Bloomberg Terminal, I spent time navigating the various pages but was tipped off by my colleague to explore BQuant, a Jupyter Notebook variation ran within Bloomberg Terminal. Being in a lean team, the lack of resources led to me taking the initiative to pick up BQuant. I dived headfirst into understanding and learning the various packages and spent my spare time getting better with the packages. Once I understood the packages, I began building applications and dashboards for my colleagues, who were amazed at the responsiveness and simplicity of it compared to big and clunky excel notebooks. Through this experience, I learnt how to work with non-specialists and translate their wants into a finished product. Deciphering the problem statement is half the battle won.

Last summer, I interned at the Monetary Authority of Singapore as a Data Analyst Intern for the Reserve Fund Management Department. Here, we aimed to analyse and predict the behaviour of funds so that the Singapore Government could attain the best returns. Being the only data analyst on a team of finance specialists, I was tasked with creating machine learning models such as linear regression and time series analysis to achieve this goal. Working in a government organization opened my eyes to how many individuals work together to be part of a bigger picture. We worked with numerous other departments to get information, work on it, then pass it off. Through this experience, I am sure that I will be able to work in a big or small organization and communicate well with others.
